An art researcher, theorist and curator from Ukraine, as well as the author of several individual monographs, co-author of collective monographs, articles, and projects related to the new epistemological and aesthetic potential of visual art forms in Ukraine. In 2003, she completed her PhD studies at the Kyiv National University of Culture and Arts, defending her thesis on the 1960ies Ukrainian artist Viktor Zaretskyi, and for the first time in the historical art discourse of Ukraine analyzed the chronological and geographical aspects of resistance, non-conformism, Soviet-era art, the main guidelines of its movement, and the diversity of art schools (Kyiv, Kharkiv, Odesa, Lviv, and Transcarpathian).

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
